STYLE GUIDE FOR THE CORPORATE LOOK

- Tailored suit with sharp dress shirt is what we are after.
- For ties, bring at least three options, all which compliment or can be used with the shirt(s) you are bringing. Red, blue, purple and black ties are good colours for this photo shoot.
- For a more polished look with style, feel free to bring suit vest or a couple of pocket squares.
- Flattering colors for dress shirts are usually French blue or purple in combination with a dark gray, navy blue or black suit jacket.
- Very busy multi color prints, stripes (big or small), neon colors, all white, and all black—are not the best choices for a photo shoot, unless discussed with the photographer prior to your session.

STYLE GUIDE FOR THE CASUAL BUSINESS LOOK

- Dress shirts are always a great choice as the photographer can always dress it up or dress it down. Bring an undershirt if this is necessary.
- If you normally wear a tie, bring at least three options, all which compliment or can be used with the shirt(s) you are bringing.
- Jackets and blazers with a casual shirt underneath are great for a more relaxed look.
- Flattering colors for men are usually French blue or purple in combination with a dark gray, navy blue or black jacket.
- Bring outfits that fit you the best and make you look sharp.



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
